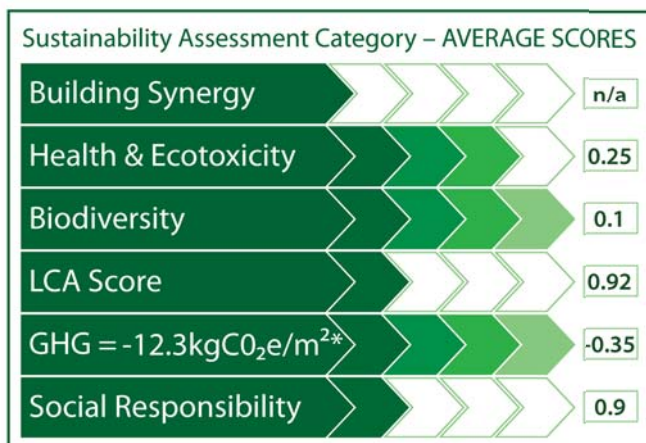

## *Conditions of Licence*

The conditions of licence are contained in full in the GreenTag™ Standard, Terms and Conditions, Licence Agreement and Rules for the Use of the Mark Documents as sighted and/or executed by the Licensee.
